

Lackland AFB Entry Procedures

If you have an active/retired military/military civil service identification card, all you have to do is show that card at any entry control point. If you do not have one of those cards and you need base access there are two ways to get on. The **easiest** is to ride along with someone who has one of the above mentioned identification cards. If that is not possible, you must be sponsored onto base.

The FTVA will sponsor FTVA members on base for reunion related events. In order for us to sponsor anyone on base, the Lackland AFB Security Forces require all sponsored guest's full name, telephone number, driver's license state/number and their date of birth be provided to them with enough lead time so they can run criminal background checks.

If you will need to be sponsored onto Lackland AFB, please fill out the below form and mail it to the below address **before August 15th**. If anyone will be in the vehicle with you, please include the same information for each individual. We will send you any new information regarding base access and a map showing which gates you will be allowed to use to access Lackland AFB.
